## **BAANZ Long Jump Rules 2024**

## ENTRIES CLOSE 5 PM 14TH APRIL. FLIGHTS CAN BE ATTEMPTED AT ANY TIME WITHIN THE MONTHS OF APRIL AND MAY 2024.

- 1. Any financial BAANZ pilot may enter with any balloon. A pilot must submit an entry form BEFORE undertaking their first flight but may submit as many attempts as they like.
- 2. The winner of the Long Jump is the pilot who flies the longest straight-line distance within New Zealand during the months of April and May 2024.
- 3. Safety is to remain paramount at all times.
- 4. Intermediate landings are not permitted.
- 5. The judge's decision is final.
- 6. An entry fee of \$25 must be paid at the time of submitting an entry form. Direct payment can be made to ANZ Bank Account 06-0317-0937619-00. Please use the pilot's first initial and surname in the reference field.
- 7. The competition window starts on the morning of April 1st 2024 and closes on the evening of 31st May 2024.
- 8. A balloon flight tracking app must be used to track the entirety of an attempt and create a 'flight log'.
- 9. Each entrant shall send their flight logs and completed written log form to the BAANZ secretary BEFORE 7th June 2024.
- 10. The winners will be announced at a prize-giving.
- 11. Each entrant can receive a copy of the collated reports following the completion of the prize-giving if requested.
- 12. The 'Frog' award is awarded to the outright winner who flew the longest straight-line distance. The 'Flea' award may be awarded to a pilot who flew the furthest in a small balloon, or who did exceedingly well in another fashion and therefore merits a second place on the winners' podium.
